







Handling a Bleeding Injury in Lab Class

<p>1</p>		<p>➤ Call Public Safety (541) 463-5555 if injury is severe.</p>
<p>2</p>		<p>➤ Wear nitrile gloves and safety goggles, if you treat someone else's bleeding wound.</p>
<p>3</p>		<p>➤ Have injured person rinse the cut with water and wash it with soap.</p>
<p>4</p>		<p>➤ Secure gauze / bandage. ➤ Have injured person put pressure on wound with gauze, while holding wound above heart if possible.</p>
<p>5</p>		<p>➤ If bleeding does not stop in 10 minutes, call Public Safety at (541) 463-5555.</p>
<p>6</p>		<p>➤ Fill out accident/incident report.</p>
