 - Leadership Team Model important:
 - Continuity, sustainability, effective management of a large, complex task.
 - Discuss ongoing need for coaching—reassignment time has been key for effective coaching. Reassignment time for coaching should be written into long-term planning.
 - Also key to coach on how to coach: focus on inquiry-based questions and answers (not
 just a description or aspiration). Useful area of exploration has been trying to figure out
 the relationship between the data in standard data package and the data required for
 understanding programs and planning for futures. (Kate's note/comment: may need
 assistance with administering surveys using the COW)
