Lane County Cultural Coalition announces Cultural Opportunity Grants and grant writing workshops

The Lane County Cultural Coalition (LCCC) offers Cultural Opportunity Grants to provide county recognition and support to significant cultural programs and projects, preserving and enhancing Lane County's diverse arts, heritage, and humanities efforts.

Cultural Opportunity Grants are available to for-profit and nonprofit organizations and individuals to support access, awareness, and education for programs and projects related to arts, heritage and humanities. Grant amounts range from \$500 to \$2,500.

For several years, LCCC has hosted several grant writing workshops around Lane County to assist first time grant writers. These workshops are formatted to encourage individual artists as well as assist all grant seekers in their grant preparation.
