Examples

In Fall 03, there were 2,424 students entering Lane for the first time. Of those, 831 had attempted 27 credits over the following two yrs.

Of the 831, 199 (24%) tested into the math class required for their self-declared program (degree-ready).

Of the 831 F03 cohort, 276 (33%) tested below the math class required for their self-declared program AND they had completed (within four years) the lower level math classes necessary for enrolling in the math course required by their self-declared program (not degree-ready but were developmental completers).

Of the 831 F03 cohort, 356 (43%) tested below the math class required for their self-declared program and they had NOT completed the lower level math classes within four years (not degree-ready and were not developmental completers).
