A central component of Lane’s mission is helping our award-seeking students achieve summative goals of graduation and/or transfer.

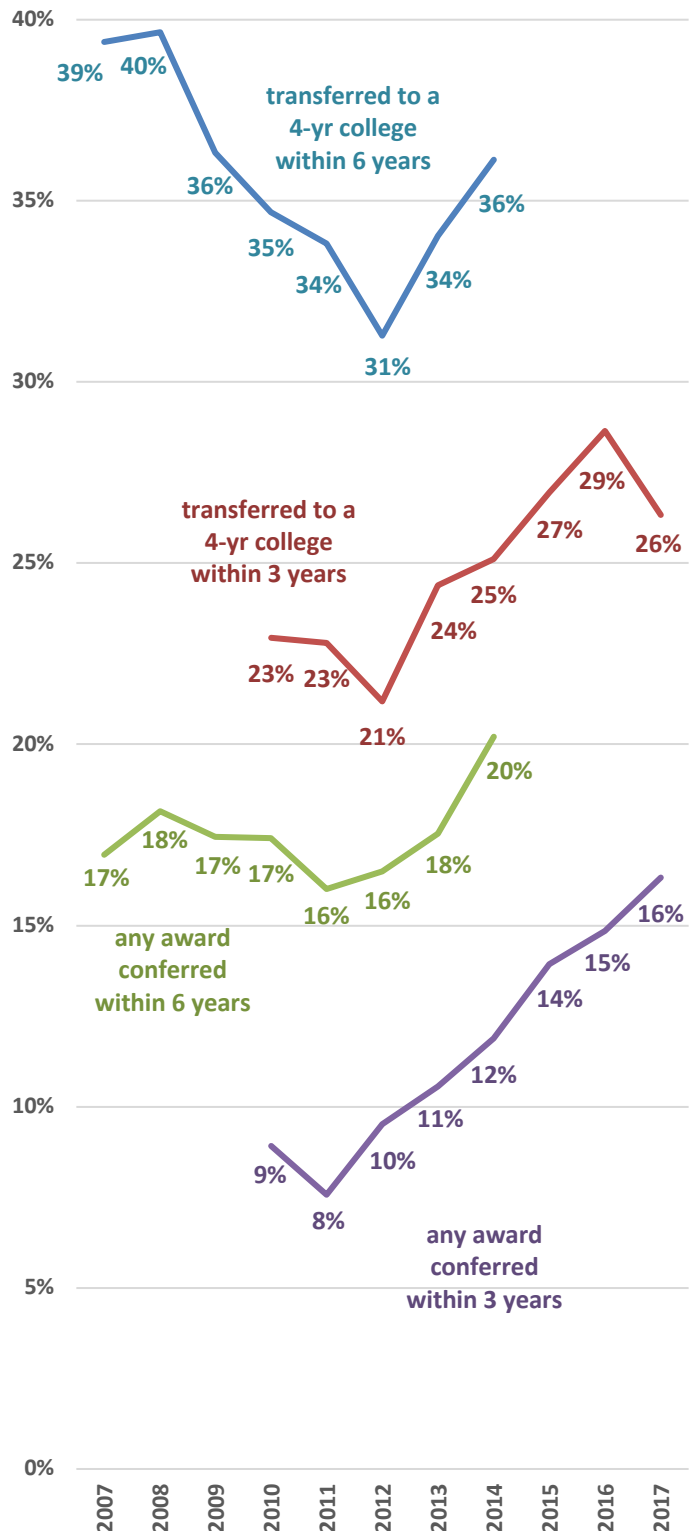
MFI 15: Students Completing Degrees or Certificates within 3 and 6 Years

MFI 16: Award-Seeking Students Transferring to Four-Year Institutions in 3 and 6 Years

This chart shows all four rates from MFI 15 and MFI 16 for the most recent eight fall cohorts available. **Graduation rates have increased since 2011. The 3-year any award rate doubled from 2011 to 2017. Except for 2017, transfer rates have also increased each year since 2012.**

Many variables impact graduation and transfer, but it is perhaps no coincidence that since 2011 Lane has sustained focused efforts to improve student success outcomes under frameworks of Achieving the Dream and Guided Pathways. We are seeing the results of continuous improvement.

MFI 15 and 16 scorecards set short-term goals to improve graduation and transfer rates by an additional 1 to 3%. *Let’s keep this going!*
